Donna Strachan



Graduated from the AECC in 2001 with a Master's in Chiropractic. Donna began working with the English Institute of Sport in a lecturing and consultancy capacity in 2009 which was her introduction into Sports Chiropractic. Since then she has experienced a number of sports including England Rugby, British Athletics, England FA and British Skiing. Donna worked at the Polyclinic within the Athlete's Village at the London 2012 Olympics and the Polyclinic within the Athlete's Village at the 2015 Baku European Games. Donna's particular areas of interest are Instrument Assisted Soft Tissue Manipulation (IASTM) and Taping Technique. In 2007 Donna was approached to teach for Graston Technique and subsequently for FAKTR within the UK and Europe. In 2010 Donna developed the I-Assist Instrument and then in 2012 the Kinnective Instrument and Course alongside Sports Chiropractor Kay Pearce and Sports Physiotherapist Mike Chisholm. Donna lectures Nationally and Internationally in IASTM, Taping, Manipulation and Exercise & Injury Prevention. In clinic Donna works from her Merseyside based practices which house Physiotherapy, Chiropractic in-house Strength and Conditioning.



Sarah Dion



is a graduate from the Université du Québec in Trois-Rivières in 2013. She then completed a full-time three-year residency in diagnostic imaging at the Canadian Memorial Chiropractic College in Toronto, where she acquired an extensive clinical experience during several orthopedic and chiropractic placements in different hospitals. Dre. Dion has observed several chiropractic, medical and musculoskeletal radiologists, mainly in Canada, the United States and Australia. She graduated as a chiropractic radiologist (DACBR) in September 2016. Since September 2017 she works as a full-time professor at the Institut Franco-Européen de Chiropraxie, in France, where she teaches courses in radiology.



Hélène Bourhis-Bois



is a Prof. at the UFP (University Fernando Pessoa, Porto), where she is the head of the education department for somatic psycho-education. As a practitioner of DBM and as a former nurse, masseur-physiotherapist, she is now an internationally recognized specialist in the field of somato psycho-education. She holds a PhD in Education Sciences, thesis in 2012: « Toucher manuel de relation sur le mode du Sensible et intelligence sensorielle » and is a researcher of the CERAP (Center for Study and Research of Perceptual Psychoeducation). She will talk to us, among others, about DBM (Danis Bois Method) fasciatherapy: a soft tissue manual therapy, as well as aspects of the body/mind integrated approach of somatic psycho-education. DBM fasciatherapy improves physiotherapists effectiveness on physical pain and mental suffering.
